



On November 13-14, 2017, Dr. Mohammadreza Sardari was traveling on a Greyhound bus from the Dallas, Texas area to a conference in Kansas City, Missouri as a validly ticketed passenger. At approximately 2:45 a.m. on the morning of November 14, 2017, while stopped in Wichita, Kansas, Dr. Sardari was removed from the bus he was riding. In response to inquiries from various media outlets, a Greyhound spokesperson previously stated that Dr. Sardari was removed due to unruly behavior and failure to cooperate and that the police were called in connection with this event. Greyhound hereby fully retracts its public statement regarding Dr. Sardari, including the statement that Dr. Sardari was unruly and failed to cooperate. Further, the Wichita police have no record of being contacted in connection with these events, and Greyhound also fully retracts its statement that police were called to remove Dr. Sardari from the bus he was riding. Greyhound sincerely apologizes to Dr. Sardari regarding the events that occurred. Greyhound reaffirms that Greyhound did not act in a discriminatory manner in connection with these events.
